### OTHER INFORMATION REGARDING COURSES

#### **ASA Level 1 course [formerly Assistant Teachers Certificate]**

**Requirements:** Candidates must be 16 years of age or over  
During practical sessions you may be required to assist in the water, but the majority of the practical work will take place on the poolside. There is a written exam [45 minutes].

**Course fee: £105.00 payable to the “ASA Teachers Centre”**

**Exam fee: £42.50 payable to “Amateur Swimming Association”**

Book required: “ASA Introduction to Teaching & Coaching Level One”

#### **ASA Level 2 course [Units 1—4]**

**Pre-course requirements:** Candidates must be 18 years of age and hold one of the following:

- ASA Level 1 Certificate [formerly Assistant Teachers Certificate]
- ASA Preliminary Club Coach
- ASA Preliminary Teachers Certificate

All candidates must have 15 hours certified teaching experience  
During practical sessions you may be required to teach in the water, but the majority of practical work will take place on the poolside.  
There is a written exam [2 hours].

**Course fee: £180.00 payable to the “ASA Teachers Centre”**

**Exam fee: £60.50 payable to “Amateur Swimming Association”**

Books: “ASA Teaching Coaching Level Two”  
Laws of sport and Teacher’s Log Book

#### **ASA Level 2 course [Unit 4 only]**

**Pre-course requirement:** Candidates must be 18 years of age and hold one of the following:

- ASA Level 1 Certificate [formerly Assistant Teachers Certificate]
- ASA Preliminary Club Coach
- ASA Preliminary Teachers Certificate

All candidates must have 15 hours certified teaching experience  
There is a written exam [35mins].
